## ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Surabaya Intercultural School is a non-profit, independent, coeducational day school offering a university preparatory education from Early Childhood to Grade 12. Led by local and expat faculty of 29 secondary teachers, 22 seniors will be eligible for graduation in the 2024-2025 school year.

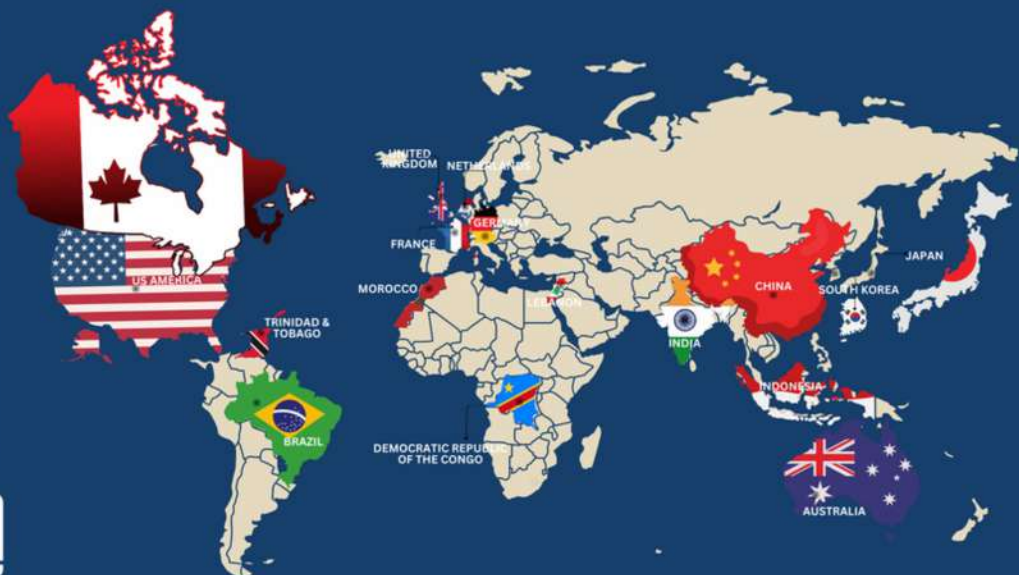
SIS was founded in 1971 as the American Consulate School. The name was changed in 1977 to the Surabaya International School which remained until 2014 when the name of the school was changed to the current Surabaya Intercultural School. The school is licensed by the Ministry of Education of Indonesia and accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC)

## GRADING AND CREDIT

SIS calculates GPA on a 4.0 scale, and we do not rank. Only courses taken at SIS are used in the calculation of GPA. A minimum of 26 credits is required for graduation. One credit is equal to a full academic year. By order of the Indonesian Ministry of Education all students must take Bahasa Indonesia each year. Students transferring to high school at SIS receive transfer credit for courses taken at their previous school

## THE CURRICULUM

At SIS, the language of instruction is English. SIS offers the IB Primary Years Program (PYP) from Early Childhood to Grade 5. For secondary school, SIS has adopted the AERO standards for learning. This curriculum is standards based allowing students to demonstrate mastery. It is an international curriculum with English/language arts, social studies, foreign language, and math based on Common Core Standards. Science is based on Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS).

SIS also offers a wide variety of AP courses at the high school level; these are college-level courses meeting the College Board curriculum standards

developed for the AP program. This year, we introduced Pre-AP classes for our high school students. Aligned with the College Board's AP Program, Pre-AP grade-level instruction is designed to develop the skills necessary for future success in AP courses.

2024 marks "Year of Literacy" for SIS. We have an ongoing evaluation process of our teaching, learning, and curriculum development. We are proud to have been recognized as an Apple Distinguished School starting from this academic year.

## COMMUNITY SERVICES AND LEARNING

Surabaya Intercultural School believes that meeting within a particular community and providing service allows students to exchange ideas and benefit from teamwork, achievement, and learning. Community Service and Learning at SIS is a collaborative, well-planned sequence of activities designed to challenge students to show initiative, demonstrate perspective, and develop skills such as cooperation, problem-solving and decision making.
